AN ACT to amend the mental hygiene law, in relation to certifying recovery living residences

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. The mental hygiene law is amended by adding a new section 2 32.05-a to read as follows:
- 3 § 32.05-a Certification of recovery living residences.
- Notwithstanding section 32.05 of this article, the commissioner may authorize the certification of recovery living residences. "Recovery
- 6 living residences" shall mean any residence located in New York state
- 7 where the owner or operator of such residence holds the residence out to
- 8 the public as a living environment for persons recovering from substance
- 9 <u>use disorder</u>, where no formal treatment substance use disorder services
- 10 are provided on-site. The department shall create a list of certified
- 11 recovery residences and make such list publicly available on their
- 12 website.
- 13 § 2. This act shall take effect on the thirtieth day after it shall
- 14 have become a law.
