AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to parking spaces for handicapped persons

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Paragraph (b) of subdivision 4 of section 502 of the vehi-2 cle and traffic law, as amended by chapter 513 of the laws of 2019, is 3 amended and a new paragraph (i) is added to read as follows:

4 (b) Upon successful completion of the requirements set forth in para-5 graph (a) of this subdivision which shall include an alcohol and drug education component as described in paragraph (c) of this subdivision, a б 7 "Road Rage" awareness component as described in paragraph (c-1) of this 8 subdivision and a "Work Zone Safety" awareness component as described in 9 paragraph (c-2) of this subdivision, a "Motorcycle Safety" awareness 10 component as described in paragraph (c-3) of this subdivision, and a "School Bus Safety" awareness component as described in paragraph (c-4) 11 12 of this subdivision, and instruction in the laws relating to parking spaces for the handicapped as described in paragraph (i) of this subdi-13 14 **vision**, the commissioner shall cause the applicant to take a road test 15 in a representative vehicle of a type prescribed by the commissioner 16 which shall be appropriate to the type of license for which application is made, except that the commissioner may waive the road test require-17 ments for certain classes of applicants. The commissioner shall have the 18 power to establish a program to allow persons other than employees of 19 20 the department to conduct road tests in representative vehicles when 21 such tests are required for applicants to obtain a class A, B or C 22 license. If <u>he or</u> she chooses to do so, <u>he or</u> she shall set forth <u>his or</u> 23 her reasons in writing and conduct a public hearing on the matter. 24 [She] <u>He or she</u> shall only establish such a program after holding the 25 public hearing.
