AN ACT to amend the election law, in relation to increasing the number of days permitted for early voting

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Subdivision 1 of section 8-600 of the election law, as 2 added by chapter 6 of the laws of 2019, is amended to read as follows:

- 1. Beginning the [tenth] seventeenth day prior to any general, prima4 ry, run-off primary pursuant to subdivision one of section 6-162 of this
  5 chapter or special election for any public or party position except for
  6 such an election held pursuant to title two of article six or article
  7 fifteen of this chapter, and ending on and including the second day
  8 prior to such general, primary, run-off primary or special election for
  9 such public office or party position, persons duly registered and eligi10 ble to vote at such election shall be permitted to vote as provided in
  11 this title. The board of elections shall establish procedures, subject
  12 to approval of the state board of elections, to ensure that persons who
  13 vote during the early voting period shall not be permitted to vote
  14 subsequently in the same election.
- 15 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
