AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to establishing the misdemeanor of unlawful concealment of identity; and providing for the repeal of such provisions upon expiration thereof

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. The penal law is amended by adding a new section 240.11 to 2 read as follows:
- 3 § 240.11 Unlawful concealment of identity.
- A person is guilty of unlawful concealment of identity when he or she wears any mask, false whiskers or any personal disguise, whether complete or partial, for the purpose of:
- 7 <u>1. evading or escaping discovery, recognition or identification in the</u> 8 commission of any crime; or
- 9 <u>2. concealment, flight or escape, when charged with, arrested for or 10 convicted of, any crime.</u>
- 11 Any person violating any of the provisions of this section shall be 12 deemed guilty of a misdemeanor.
- 13 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately and shall expire and be 14 deemed repealed December 31, 2021.
