AN ACT to amend the state finance law, in relation to establishing state procurement goals for New York state products throughout state agencies and private entities performing state contracts

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. The state finance law is amended by adding a new section
2 163-c to read as follows:

3 § 163-c. Procurement goals for New York state products in state agen-
4 cies. 1. For the purposes of this section, the following terms shall
5 have the following meanings:

6 (a) "State agency" shall mean any department, agency, board, public
7 benefit corporation, public authority or commission.

8 (b) "New York state product" shall mean an item that is grown,
9 harvested, manufactured or produced in any way in this state.

10 2. (a) In order to create, strengthen, and expand local economies
11 throughout New York, it shall be the goal of this state that twenty
12 percent of all products purchased by state agencies or by private enti-
13 ties while performing state contracts, shall, by two thousand twenty-
14 two, be New York state products.

15 (b) To meet the goals set forth in this section, when a state agency
16 contract for the purchase of products is to be awarded to the lowest
17 responsible bidder, an otherwise qualified bidder who will fulfill the
18 contract through the use of New York state products may be given prefer-
19 ence over other bidders, provided that the cost included in the bid of
20 New York state products is not more than ten percent greater than the
21 cost included in a bid that is not for New York state products.

22 3. (a) The president of the empire state development corporation shall
23 promulgate rules and regulations that would allow for state agencies to
24 be granted a waiver from the requirements of this section if such agency

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1 can prove that it is not able to meet the thresholds set forth in this
2 section.

3 (b) For private entities performing state contracts, the state agency
4 overseeing the performance of such contract shall promulgate rules and
5 regulations to allow for private entities to be granted a waiver from
6 the requirements of this section if a private entity can prove that is
7 not able to meet the thresholds set forth in this section.

8 § 2. This act shall take effect on the thirtieth day after it shall
9 have become a law.
