AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to aggravated harassment of a police officer

## The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. The penal law is amended by adding a new section 240.33 to 2 read as follows:

3 <u>§ 240.33 Aggravated harassment of a police officer.</u>

A person is guilty of aggravated harassment of a police officer when, 4 5 with intent to harass, annoy, threaten or alarm a person whom he or she б knows or reasonably should know to be a police officer, he or she causes 7 or attempts to cause such police officer to come into contact with 8 bottles, rocks, flammable liquids, hazardous or dangerous substances or objects, blood, seminal fluid, urine, feces, saliva or the contents of a 9 toilet bowl, by throwing, tossing, intentionally expectorating or expel-10 11 ling such fluid or material. 12 The term "police officer" shall mean a police officer as defined in 13 subdivision thirty-four of section 1.20 of the criminal procedure law. 14 Aggravated harassment of a police officer is a class D felony.

15 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
