AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to extortion or coercion related to immigration status

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Section 135.60 of the penal law is amended by adding a new 2 subdivision 10 to read as follows:
- 3 <u>10. Report his or her immigration status or suspected immigration</u> 4 <u>status.</u>
- 5 § 2. Subparagraph (iv) of paragraph (e) of subdivision 2 of section 6 155.05 of the penal law is amended to read as follows:
- 7 (iv) Accuse some person of a crime or cause criminal charges <u>or</u> 8 <u>removal proceedings</u> to be instituted against him <u>or her</u>; or
- 9 § 3. This act shall take effect on the thirtieth day after it shall 10 have become a law.
