AN ACT to amend the agriculture and markets law, in relation to prohibiting ear clipping and tail docking of dogs and cats unless deemed medically necessary to protect the life or health of the dog or cat

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. The section heading and subdivision 1 of section 365 of the
2 agriculture and markets law, as amended by chapter 458 of the laws of
3 1985, are amended to read as follows:

4 Clipping or cutting the ears of dogs and cats. 1. Whoever clips or
5 cuts off or causes or procures another to clip or cut off the whole or
6 any part of an ear of any dog or cat unless an anesthetic shall have
7 been given to the dog or cat and the operation performed by a licensed
8 veterinarian who deems such operation medically necessary to protect the
9 life or health of the dog or cat, is guilty of a misdemeanor, punishable
10 by imprisonment for not more than one year, or a fine of not more than
11 one thousand dollars, or by both.

12 § 2. The agriculture and markets law is amended by adding a new
13 section 365-a to read as follows:

14 § 365-a. Docking dog and cat tails; unlawful. 1. Any person who cuts
15 the bone, tissue, muscles or tendons of the tail of any dog or cat, or
16 otherwise operates upon it in any manner for the purpose or with the
17 effect of docking or otherwise altering the natural carriage or length
18 of the tail, or assists, procures, promotes or encourages such cutting
19 or operation for reasons other than to protect the life or health of the
20 dog or cat as deemed necessary by a duly licensed veterinarian, is guilty
21 of a misdemeanor punishable by a fine of not more than five hundred
22 dollars.

1 2. The provisions of this section shall not apply to any dog or cat,
2 or person who is the owner or possessor of any dog or cat whose tail has
3 been certified as having been docked, cut or altered prior to August
4 first, two thousand twenty-one.

5 § 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
