AN ACT to amend the public authorities law, in relation to establishing a standing advisory committee within the metropolitan transportation authority to improve bicycle and pedestrian access at its bridges and passenger stations

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. The public authorities law is amended by adding a new 2 section 1279-m to read as follows:

§ 1279-m. Permanent advisory committee on bicycle and pedestrian access. 1. There is hereby established a permanent advisory committee within the authority to study, investigate, monitor and make recommendations with respect to the maintenance and improvement of bicycle and pedestrian access at all bridges and passenger stations operated by the authority.

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8 2. Such committee shall consist of thirteen members appointed by the 9 10 governor, of whom two shall be appointed upon nomination by the tempo-11 rary president of the senate, two upon nomination by the speaker of the 12 assembly, one upon nomination by the minority leader of the senate and 13 one upon nomination by the minority leader of the assembly. All members 14 shall serve for a term of three years, except that, of the two members first appointed upon nomination by the temporary president of the 15 senate, one shall serve for a term of two years and one shall serve for 16 17 a term of one year; of the two members first appointed upon nomination 18 by the speaker of the assembly, one shall serve for a term of two years 19 and one shall serve for a term of one year; and, of two of the members 20 first appointed by the governor without nomination by any other person, two shall each serve for a term of two years and two shall each serve 21 for a term of one year. One of the members appointed to the management 23 advisory board directly by the governor shall be designated by the

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1 governor to serve as its chairman. Vacancies occurring in the membership 2 of the committee shall be filled in the same manner as original appoint-3 ments.

- 3. The advisory committee shall develop a strategic action plan in consultation with the authority to improve bicycle and pedestrian access at bridges, stations and other facilities operated by the authority. One component of the strategic action plan shall be to develop and monitor capital projects to allow for and/or expand bicycle access on all bridges operated by the authority and provide for bicycle parking at all passenger stations operated by the authority. The strategic action plan shall also include a review of the authority's capital program plans in effect on and after January first, two thousand twenty, to determine the impact of such projects on bicycle and pedestrian access and shall include any proposed amendments and modifications to such capital program plans that the committee deems necessary to accomplish the purposes of this section.
- 4. The committee shall hold its first meeting no later than ninety days after the effective date of this section, and at such other times as a majority of its members deem necessary, provided, however, that the committee shall meet no fewer than six times annually.
- 5. The members of the committee shall receive no compensation for their services but shall be reimbursed for their expenses actually and necessarily incurred in the performance of their duties hereunder.
- 6. The committee may request and shall receive from any department, division, board, bureau, commission, agency, public authority of the state or any political subdivision thereof such assistance and data as will enable it properly to carry out its activities hereunder and effectuate the purposes set forth herein.
- § 2. Section 1269-b of the public authorities law is amended by adding a new subdivision 11 to read as follows:
- 11. In formulating its capital program plans, the authority shall consider the impact of any proposed plan, amendment or modification submitted pursuant to this section on bicycle and pedestrian accessibility. Such consideration shall be made in consultation with the advisory committee on bicycle and pedestrian access established pursuant to section twelve hundred seventy-nine-m of this title.
 - § 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
