AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to requiring a principal, superintendent or a principal's or superintendent's designee to notify law enforcement if they believe a hate crime is occurring

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Paragraph i of subdivision 1 of section 13 of the education law, as added by chapter 102 of the laws of 2012, is amended to read as follows:

4 i. require the principal, superintendent or the principal's or superintendent's designee, to notify promptly the appropriate local law 5 6 enforcement agency when such principal, superintendent or the princi-7 pal's or superintendent's designee, believes that any harassment, bully-8 ing or discrimination constitutes criminal conduct. Where the principal, 9 superintendent or the principal's or superintendent's designee believes 10 that any harassment, bullying or discrimination constitutes a hate crime, as defined in subdivision one of section 485.05 of the penal law, 11 12 prompt notification to the appropriate local law enforcement agency 13 shall occur within forty-eight hours from the time such principal, 14 <u>superintendent</u> or the principal's or superintendent's designee believes 15 that such harassment, bullying or discrimination constitutes a hate 16 <u>crime</u>;
