AN ACT to amend the election law, in relation to requiring the county seat in Saint Lawrence county to have at least one polling place designated for early voting

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Paragraph (a) of subdivision 2 of section 8-600 of the 2 election law, as amended by chapter 344 of the laws of 2020, is amended 3 to read as follows:

(a) The board of elections shall designate polling places for early 5 voting, which may include the offices of the board of elections, for persons to vote early pursuant to this title; provided, however, that the municipality with the highest population in each county based on the latest federal decennial census, or the county seat in Saint Lawrence 9 county, shall have at least one polling place designated for early 10 voting, and to the extent practicable if such municipality has public 11 transportation routes, such polling place shall be situated along such transportation routes. There shall be so designated at least one early 13 voting polling place for every full increment of fifty thousand regis-14 tered voters in each county; provided, however, the number of early voting polling places in a county shall not be required to be greater 16 than ten unless required by any other provision of law, and a county with fewer than fifty thousand voters shall have at least one early 17 voting polling place. 18

19 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
