AN ACT to amend the public authorities law, in relation to the provision of express bus service to the south shore of Staten Island

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The public authorities law is amended by adding a new 2 section 1266-1 to read as follows:

§ 1266-1. Staten Island express bus service. The authority is hereby 4 directed to continue to fund and operate express bus service transport-

ing riders between the communities of Tottenville, Richmond Valley,

Prince's Bay, Pleasant Plains, Charleston, Woodrow and Rossville in Staten Island to the downtown and/or midtown business districts of

8 Manhattan on all routes operating such service on April thirtieth, two

9 thousand twenty-two. The authority is hereby directed to assume and

10 operate the two express bus routes serving the communities of Huquenot,

Prince's Bay, Woodrow, Rossville, Annadale and Arden Heights to the 11

midtown business district of Manhattan and being operated by Academy Bus

13 Company on April thirtieth, two thousand twenty-three and better known

14 as routes numbered X23 and X24.
