AN ACT to amend the executive law, in relation to simulation of disaster events

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Subparagraphs 17 and 18 of paragraph a of subdivision 7 of 2 section 23 of the executive law, as amended by section 4 of part B of 3 chapter 56 of the laws of 2010, are amended and a new subparagraph 19 is 4 added to read as follows:

5 (17) continued operation of governments of political subdivisions; 6 [and]

7 (18) utilization and coordination of programs to assist individuals 8 with household pets and service animals following a disaster, with 9 particular attention to means of evacuation, shelter and transportation 10 options[+]; and

(19) at least one annual simulation of both natural and man-made disaster events in the form of a tabletop exercise in which key personnel assigned emergency management roles and responsibilities gather to discuss, in a non-threatening environment, various simulated emergency situations. Such simulation shall be completed annually prior to the first of May in areas at risk of hurricane damage.

17 § 2. This act shall take effect on the one hundred twentieth day after 18 it shall have become a law. Effective immediately, the addition, amend-19 ment and/or repeal of any rule or regulation necessary for the implemen-20 tation of this act on its effective date are authorized to be made and 21 completed on or before such effective date.
