AN ACT in relation to authorizing the town of Orangetown, county of Rockland to discontinue the use of certain park land

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Subject to the provisions of this act, the town of Orange-2 town, Rockland County, acting by and through its governing body, and 3 upon such terms and conditions as determined by such body, is hereby 4 authorized to discontinue the use as park land and alienate the lands 5 described in sections three and four of this act, and convey such lands 6 by appropriate instrument to the county of Rockland, including any 7 necessary temporary easements and rights-of-way over such lands, for the purpose of the county of Rockland completing roadway safety improvements, including the replacement of a structurally deficient bridge and 10 channel realignment in order to reduce flooding in the area. Upon 11 completion of the roadway safety improvements and channel realignment by 12 the county of Rockland as authorized by this act, the county of Rockland 13 shall restore the surface of the lands more particularly described in 14 section four of this act and such lands shall continue to be used for 15 park purposes by the town.

- 16 § 2. The authorization provided in section one of this act shall be 17 effective only upon the condition that the town of Orangetown dedicate 18 an amount of land equal to or greater than the fair market value of 19 parklands being discontinued towards the acquisition of new parklands 20 and/or capital improvements to existing park and recreational facili-21 ties.
- § 3. The parklands to be alienated by the town of Orangetown, Rockland County, pursuant to section one of this act are described as follows: Parcel 1

- 38 § 4. The parklands for which a temporary easement may be granted the 39 town of Orangetown, Rockland County, to the county of Rockland pursuant to section one of this act are described as follows: 40 41

- Northeast corner of Parcel 1, along the Northerly line of Parcel 1; S 48
- 87°18'30" W 135.10 feet to the Point of Beginning. 49
- 50 Thence from said Point of Beginning;
- 1. S 87° 18' 30" W 176.83 feet; thence, 51
- 52 2. N 25° 06' 37" W 124.05 feet; thence,
- 53 3. N 10° 55' 29" W 137.83 feet; thence,
- 4. N 67° 21' 42" E 72.38 feet; thence, 54
- 5. S 19° 39' 56" E 107.61 feet; thence, 55
- 56 6. S 42° 34' 22" E 225.25 feet to the Point of Beginning.

§ 5. In the event that the town of Orangetown received any funding support or assistance from the federal government for the purchase, maintenance or improvement of the parklands set forth in sections three and four of this act, the discontinuance and alienation of such park land authorized by the provisions of this act shall not occur until the town of Orangetown has complied with any federal requirements pertaining to the alienation or conversion of parklands, including satisfying the secretary of the interior that the alienation or conversion complies with all conditions which the secretary of the interior deems necessary to assure the substitution of other lands shall be equivalent in fair market value and usefulness to the lands being alienated or converted.

14 § 6. This act shall take effect immediately.
