AN ACT in relation to authorizing the town of Orangetown, county of Rockland to discontinue the use of certain park land

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Subject to the provisions of this act, the town of Orange-2 town, Rockland County, acting by and through its governing body, and upon such terms and conditions as determined by such body, is hereby authorized to: (a) discontinue the use as park land and alienate the lands described in section three of this act, and convey such lands by 6 appropriate instrument to the county of Rockland, for the purpose of the county of Rockland completing roadway safety improvements, including the 8 replacement of a structurally deficient bridge and channel realignment in order to reduce flooding in the area; and (b) temporarily discontinue 10 the use of the parklands identified in section four of this act, for 11 such construction.

- § 2. The authorization provided in section one of this act shall be 13 effective only upon the condition that the town of Orangetown dedicate an amount of \overline{l} and equal to or greater than the fair market value of parklands being discontinued towards the acquisition of new parklands 15 16 and/or capital improvements to existing park and recreational facilities.
- 18 § 3. The parklands to be permanently alienated by the town of Orange-19 town, Rockland County, pursuant to section one of this act are described 20 as follows:
- 2.1 Parcel 1

- 8. N 87°18'30" E a distance of 311.93 feet through Tax Lot 68.14-2-26 30 to a point on the division line between Tax Lot 68.14-2-26 and Tax Lot 31 68.15-1-4; thence,

- 38 § 4. The parklands for which a temporary easement may be temporarily granted by the town of Orangetown, Rockland County, to the county of 39 Rockland pursuant to section one of this act are described as follows: 40 41 Parcel 2
- 42 All that certain piece or parcel of property, lying, being and situated in the Town of Orangetown, County of Rockland and State of New York 43 44 described as follows:
- 45 Beginning at a point on the Northerly line of Parcel 1 described in 46 subdivision (a) of section three of this act. Said point being the
- Southeast corner of parcel 2 and being the following course and distance 47 from the Northeast corner of Parcel 1, along the Northerly line of 48
- Parcel 1; S 87°18'30" W 135.10 feet to the Point of Beginning. 49
- 50 Thence from said Point of Beginning;
- 51 1. S 87° 18' 30" W 176.83 feet; thence,
- 52 2. N 25° 06' 37" W 124.05 feet; thence,
- 53 3. N 10° 55' 29" W 137.83 feet; thence,
- 4. N 67° 21' 42" E 72.38 feet; thence, 54
- 5. S 19° 39' 56" E 107.61 feet; thence, 55
- 56 6. S 42° 34' 22" E 225.25 feet to the Point of Beginning.

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1 Containing an area of 31,129 square feet more or less, or 0.714 acres

5. In the event that the town of Orangetown received any funding S 4 support or assistance from the federal government for the purchase, maintenance or improvement of the parklands set forth in sections three and four of this act, the discontinuance and alienation of such park land authorized by the provisions of this act shall not occur until the town of Orangetown has complied with any federal requirements pertaining to the alienation or conversion of parklands, including satisfying the secretary of the interior that the alienation or conversion complies 11 with all conditions which the secretary of the interior deems necessary to assure the substitution of other lands shall be equivalent in fair market value and usefulness to the lands being alienated or converted.

§ 6. Upon completion of construction by the county of Rockland as 15 authorized by this act, the county of Rockland shall restore the surface 16 of the lands more particularly described in section four of this act and such lands shall continue to be used for park purposes by the town.

§ 7. This act shall take effect immediately.
