AN ACT to amend the canal law, in relation to the general powers and duties of the canal corporation

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- Section 1. Subdivision 14 of section 10 of the canal law, as amended 2 by chapter 420 of the laws of 1968, is amended and two new subdivisions 3 6-a and 8-a are added to read as follows:
- 6-a. Cause the locks and lift bridges of the canal system to be operated annually for the passage of commercial and recreational traffic between May first and November fifteenth, generally, subject to natural conditions, weather, required maintenance, capital rehabilitation work, or other factors related to safe canal operation.
- 9 <u>8-a. Maintain and preserve the integrity of the Erie Canal's historic</u>
 10 <u>resources, including its structures, floating plant, and unique landside</u>
 11 <u>features.</u>
- 14. Permit <u>commercial</u> boat [<u>owners</u>] <u>companies</u> operating upon the canal system to use state drydocks, <u>travel lifts</u>, <u>or other facilities for required coast guard drydock inspections</u>, <u>for non-navigation season storage</u>, <u>or</u> while making emergency repairs to their vessels <u>at rates</u> prescribed under subchapter D of chapter III of title twenty-one of the

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§ 2. This act shall take effect immediately
