AN ACT to amend the social services law, in relation to a gender-neutral marker for the welfare management system

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Section 21 of the social services law is amended by adding a new subdivision 2-a to read as follows:

3 2-a. The welfare management system and any related state systems 4 required to process applications for benefits and to distribute such 5 benefits shall recognize "X" as a valid option when placed in any field б that requests information about an applicant's gender or sex. All appli-7 cation materials, instructions, public quidance, and related materials 8 associated with the benefits application process, including electronic 9 and online materials and applications shall be amended and updated to 10 clarify that any person can select or indicate a gender or sex designation of "X" when such information is requested. The content of the 11 12 gender or sex field shall not delay or otherwise hinder access to 13 services for any applicant. For the purposes of this subdivision the 14 term "X" means a gender or sex designation that is not exclusively male 15 or female.

16 § 2. This act shall take effect on the thirtieth day after it shall 17 have become a law; provided, however, that the department of social 18 services shall amend, distribute and make available any printed materi-19 als relating to benefits under any program for which the department has 20 supervisory responsibilities, including informational and instructional 21 materials and applications for benefits within one hundred twenty days 22 of the date on which this act shall have become a law.
