AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to criminalizing the filming of a violent crime

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- Section 1. The penal law is amended by adding three new sections 2 235.25, 235.26 and 235.27 to read as follows:
- 3 <u>§ 235.25 Recording</u> a video of the commission of a violent felony; defi-4 nitions of terms.
- For the purposes of sections 235.26 and 235.27, of this article the term "violent felony" means any offense described in section 70.02 of this chapter.
- 8 § 235.26 Recording a video of the commission of a violent felony.
- 9 A person is guilty of recording a video of the commission of a violent 10 felony when he or she:
- 1. wilfully records a video of the commission of a violent felony with
 12 intent to promote or encourage the commission of the underlying violent
 13 felony; or
- 2. conspires with another to record a video of the commission of a violent felony with intent to promote or encourage the commission of the underlying violent felony.
- Recording a video of the commission of a violent felony is a class E 18 felony.
- 19 <u>§ 235.27 Recording</u> a video of the commission of a violent felony; limi-20 tations.
- Submission of the video described in section 235.26 of this article by the person recording the video to law enforcement at the first reason-
- 23 able opportunity may be considered as evidence that the person lacked
- 24 the intent to promote or encourage the commission of the underlying
- 25 <u>violent felony.</u>
- § 2. This act shall take effect on the first of November next succeeding the date on which it shall have become a law.
