AN ACT to amend the social services law, in relation to requiring child care providers to be trained on the impacts and dangers of congenital cytomegalovirus infection and the treatments and methods of prevention of cytomegalovirus infection

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as "Elizabeth's 2 law".
 - § 2. Subparagraphs (ix) and (x) of paragraph (b) of subdivision 3 of section 390-a of the social services law, subparagraph (ix) as amended and subparagraph (x) as added by chapter 675 of the laws of 2019, are amended to read as follows:
- 7 (ix) for operators, program directors, employees and assistants of 8 family day care homes, group family day care homes and child day care 9 centers, education and information on the identification, diagnosis and 10 prevention of shaken baby syndrome; [and]
- 11 (x) adverse childhood experiences (ACEs), focused on understanding 12 trauma and on nurturing resiliency; and
- 13 (xi) occurrence, transmission, birth defects, methods of diagnosis and 14 preventive measures of Cytomegalovirus.
- § 3. This act shall take effect on the one hundred eightieth day after it shall have become a law. Effective immediately, the addition, amendment and/or repeal of any rule or regulation necessary for the implementation of this act on its effective date are authorized to be made and completed on or before such effective date.
