AN ACT to amend the correction law, in relation to integrating community supervision programs into an individual's employment, educational or vocational training schedule

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- Section 1. Subdivision 5 of section 201 of the correction law, as added by section 32 of subpart A of part C of chapter 62 of the laws of 2011, is amended to read as follows:
- 5. The department shall assist inmates eligible for community supervision and [inmates] individuals who are on community supervision to
 secure employment, educational or vocational training, and housing. Any
 program the department requires a person on community supervision to
 take as a condition of such supervision shall not unreasonably interfere
 with such person's employment, educational or vocational training schedule unless such program is a residential treatment program.
- 11 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
