- AN ACT to amend the correction law, in relation to custody and visitation rights of a sex offender

## The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

## 1 Section 1. Section 168-w of the correction law, as relettered by chap-2 ter 604 of the laws of 2005, is renumbered section 168-x and a new 3 section 168-w is added to read as follows:

4 § 168-w. Custody and visitation rights. 1. Any sex offender designated as a sexual predator, or a sexually violent offender, or classified as a 5 level three risk, for a crime involving a child shall be, except in б extraordinary circumstances, prohibited from being granted by a court 7 8 physical or legal custody of, or unsupervised visitation with, a child. 9 2. Any sex offender classified as a level three risk shall be presumed 10 to be ineligible to be granted physical or legal custody of, or unsupervised visitation with, a child, and a court shall grant physical or 11 12 legal custody of, or unsupervised visitation with, a child only if the 13 sex offender has provided clear and convincing evidence that granting 14 such custody or visitation will be in the best interest of the child.

15 § 2. This act shall take effect on the first of November next succeed-16 ing the date on which it shall have become a law.
