AN ACT to authorize the town of Yorktown, county of Westchester, to alienate and discontinue the use of certain parklands

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Subject to the provisions of this act, the town of York-
2 town, county of Westchester, acting by and through its governing body,
3 and upon such terms and conditions as determined by such body, is hereby
4 authorized to discontinue as parklands the lands more particularly
5 described in section three of this act, for the purpose of entering into
6 a twenty-five year lease with HESP Solar LLC for the construction of a
7 solar facility, including a canopy system, ground mount system and ener-
8 gy storage unit, and four electric vehicle charging stations at the
9 Granite Knolls Sports Complex.

10 § 2. The authorization contained in section one of this act shall take
11 effect only upon the condition that the town of Yorktown shall dedicate
12 an amount equal to or greater than the fair market value of the park-
13 lands being discontinued towards the acquisition of new parklands and/or
14 capital improvements to existing park and recreational facilities.

15 § 3. The lands authorized by section one of this act to be discontin-
16 ued as parklands are described as follows:

17 BEGINNING at a point on the westerly side of Stoney Street adjoining
18 the northerly line of land now or formerly North McLean;

19 THENCE running along the northerly line of said last mentioned land
20 and most of the way along a post and wire fence,

21 North 84 Degrees 41'28" West 298.64 feet

22 THENCE continuing along the northerly line of said land now or former-
23 ly of North McLean and along the center line of said stone wall, the
24 following courses and distances:

25 North 81 Degrees 04'40" West 42.06 feet

17 THENCE running along the southerly line of said last mentioned land,
18 South 83 Degrees 16'00" East 865.17 feet to a corner of said last
19 mentioned land; and
20 THENCE running along the easterly line of said land now or formerly of
21 Alpine Woods Inc., and most of the way along the center line of a stone
22 wall, the following courses and distances:
23 North 35 Degrees 20' East 141.56 feet
24 North 22 Degrees 29' East 23.72 feet
25 North 37 Degrees 30' East 33.20 feet
26 North 29 Degrees 34' East 86.35 feet
27 North 31 Degrees 23' East 253.15 feet
28 North 29 Degrees 22' East 273.66 feet and
29 North 29 Degrees 39' East 237.77 feet to another corner of said land
30 now or formerly of Alpine Woods Inc.;
31 THENCE running along the northerly line of said last mentioned land
32 and most of the way along the center line of a stone wall, the following
33 courses and distances:
34 North 84 Degrees 23'20" West 93.01 feet
35 North 85 Degrees 03'30" West 209 feet
36 North 72 Degrees 50'50" West 65.82 feet
37 North 70 Degrees 11'40" West 120.44 feet
38 North 69 Degrees 39'20" West 128.03 feet
39 North 74 Degrees 52'30" West 36.55 feet to the northwest corner of
40 said land now or formerly of Alpine Woods Inc., and the easterly line of
41 land shown on Map of Subdivision of Knollward Section, Property belong-
42 ing to Alpine Woods Inc. by J. Henry Carpenter & Co Surveyors, dated
43 August 15, 1941, and filed in the Office of the County Clerk, Division
44 of Land Records, Westchester County, New York, on October 30, 1941 as
45 Map No. 5465;
46 RUNNING THENCE along said land shown on said map, North 69 Degrees
47 03'30" West 67.46 feet to an angle point in said land shown on said map;
48 THENCE running along the easterly line of Lots 5 and 4 shown on said
49 map and along the center line of a stone wall, the following courses and
50 distances:
51 North 34 Degrees 11'50" East 61.80 feet
52 North 29 Degrees 21'50" East 79.95 feet
53 North 26 Degrees 18'40" East 85.19 feet
54 North 36 Degrees 32'30" East 8.61 feet and

1 North 27 Degrees 44'10" East 9.88 feet to another stone wall and
2 another angle point in said land shown on said map and lands now or
3 formerly of the New York Province of the Society of Jesus.

4 RUNNING THENCE along said lands South 84 Degrees 26'40" East 1183.97
5 feet, South 84 Degrees 05'10" East 323.71 feet and South 81 Degrees
6 07'10" East 434.67 feet to the westerly side of Stoney Street;

7 THENCE running along the westerly side of Stoney Street:

8 South 10 Degrees 17'10" West 72.12 feet

9 South 08 Degrees 45'20" West 63.03 feet

10 South 09 Degrees 23'40" West 81.85 feet

11 South 04 Degrees 45'52" West 139.08 feet and

12 South 02 Degrees 27'27" West 128.86 feet to the point of beginning.

13 § 4. In the event that the town of Yorktown received any funding
14 support or assistance from the federal government for the purchase,
15 maintenance or improvement of the parklands set forth in section three
16 of this act, the discontinuance and alienation of such parkland author-
17 ized by the provisions of this act shall not occur until the town of
18 Yorktown has complied with any federal requirements pertaining to the
19 alienation or conversion of parklands, including satisfying the secre-
20 tary of the interior that the alienation or conversion complies with all
21 conditions which the secretary of the interior deems necessary to assure
22 the substitution of other lands shall be equivalent in fair market value
23 and usefulness to the lands being alienated or converted.

24 § 5. This act shall take effect immediately.
