AN ACT to amend the civil service law, in relation to preventing outsourcing during a hiring freeze

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The civil service law is amended by adding a new section 66 to read as follows:

§ 66. Hiring freeze. Upon the enactment of a hiring freeze, no agency, department, division, commission, bureau or any other entity under the authority of the executive department shall contract, subcontract or hire any third party to perform services that would otherwise be carried out by an employee whose terms of employment are subject to a collective bargaining agreement or other analogous contract and who is subject to such hiring freeze.

§ 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
