AN ACT to authorize the town of Binghamton, county of Broome, to alienate and discontinue the use of certain parklands for the purpose of accommodating equipment and serving as a training facility for the Town of Binghamton Volunteer Fire Department

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Subject to the provisions of this act, the town of Bingham-  
2 ton, county of Broome, acting by and through its governing body, is  
3 hereby authorized to discontinue the use of parklands and alienate such  
4 lands more particularly described in section three of this act, to the  
5 Town of Binghamton Volunteer Fire Department Station #3, for the purpose  
6 of accommodating equipment and serving as a training facility for the  
7 Fire Department.

8 § 2. The authorization contained in section one of this act shall take  
9 effect only upon the condition that the town of Binghamton shall dedi-  
10 cate an amount equal to or greater than the fair market value of the  
11 parklands being discontinued towards the acquisition of new parklands  
12 and/or capital improvements to existing park and recreational facili-  
13 ties.

14 § 3. The parklands authorized by section one of this act to be discon-  
15 tinued as parklands are described as follows:

16 All that tract, piece or parcel of land situate in the Town of Bing-  
17 hamton, County of Broome and State of New York, described as follows:  
18 Being all that parcel of land commencing in the east line of the Old  
19 Hawleyton Turnpike at the northwest corner of lands of the party of the  
20 second part herein, thence running northerly along the easterly line of  
21 the said highway, one hundred and six point three (106.3) feet; thence  
22 running east on a line parallel to the original south line of the second  
23 party herein two hundred seventy-seven point sixty-four (277.64) feet to

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1 a point; thence running south at right angles to the last described line  
2 two hundred two point fifty-four (202.54) feet to a point; thence at  
3 right angles to the last described line westerly one hundred thirty-sev-  
4 en point eighty-three (137.83) feet to the original southeast corner of  
5 premises of the second party herein; thence northerly along the east  
6 line of second party ninety-eight point eighteen (98.18) feet to the  
7 northeast corner of the second party and thence westerly along the north  
8 line of the said second party one hundred sixty (160) feet to the place  
9 of beginning. Containing one acre be the same more or less.

10 Being the same premises described on the Broome County Tax Map of the  
11 Town of Binghamton as Parcel No. 2-9-28.

12 § 4. In the event that the town of Binghamton received any funding  
13 support or assistance from the federal government for the purchase,  
14 maintenance or improvement of the parklands set forth in section three  
15 of this act, the discontinuance and alienation of such parkland author-  
16 ized by the provisions of this act shall not occur until the town of  
17 Binghamton has complied with any federal requirements pertaining to the  
18 alienation or conversion of parklands, including satisfying the secre-  
19 tary of the interior that the alienation or conversion complies with all  
20 conditions which the secretary of the interior deems necessary to assure  
21 the substitution of other lands shall be equivalent in fair market value  
22 and usefulness to the lands being alienated or converted.

23 § 5. This act shall take effect immediately.
