AN ACT to amend chapter 333 of the laws of 2018 amending the general business law relating to the one-call notification system, in relation to making such provisions permanent; and to repeal certain provisions of such chapter relating thereto

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- Section 1. Section 9 of chapter 333 of the laws of 2018 amending the 2 general business law relating to the one-call notification system, is amended to read as follows:
- § 9. This act shall take effect on the one hundred eightieth day after it shall have become a law[ + provided, however, that section three of this act shall expire and be deemed repealed October 1, 2021 when upon such date section four of this act shall take effect; provided, further, 8 however, that sections five, seven and eight of this act shall expire 9 and be deemed repealed October 1, 2021].
- § 2. Section 4 of chapter 333 of the laws of 2018 amending the general 10 11 business law relating to the one-call notification system is REPEALED.
- § 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
