AN ACT to amend the state technology law, in relation to the payment of ransom in the event of a cyber incident or a cyber ransom or ransom-

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The state technology law is amended by adding a new article 4 to read as follows:

- b. "Cyber ransom or ransomware" means a type of malware that encrypts
 or locks valuable digital files and demands a ransom to release the
 files.
- c. "Governmental entity" shall mean any state, city, town or village or local department, board, bureau, division, commission, committee,

- 20 or office, including all entities defined pursuant to section two of the

- New York and the city university of New York as well as the state legislature, the judiciary or state and local legislatures.
- 3 <u>d. "Business entity" shall mean any legal entity that conducts busi-</u> 4 <u>ness in the state of New York.</u>
- 5 <u>e. "Health care entity" shall mean hospitals, nursing homes, home</u>
 6 <u>care, hospice and any other health care facilities regulated by the</u>
 7 <u>department of health.</u>
- 2. No governmental entity, business entity or health care entity within the state shall pay, or have another entity pay on their behalf, ransom in the event of a cyber incident or a cyber ransom or ransomware attack.
- 3. All governmental entities shall report any cyber incidents and cyber ransom or ransomware attacks to the New York state division of homeland security and emergency services.
- 15 <u>4. A fine of up to ten thousand dollars for each affected party per</u> 16 <u>incident may be issued for any violation of subdivision two of this</u> 17 <u>section.</u>
- 18 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
