AN ACT to repeal section 5 of chapter 254 of the laws of 2013 relating to authorizing the New York state thruway authority to convey certain land located in the village of Canastota, county of Madison relating to the use and development of such land; and to release a reverter and easement relating to such land

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Section 5 of chapter 254 of the laws of 2013 relating to
2 authorizing the New York state thruway authority to convey certain land
3 located in the village of Canastota, county of Madison is REPEALED.

4 § 2. Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, the New York state
5 thruway authority shall release to the International Boxing Hall of
6 Fame, Inc the existing permanent easement restricting occupancy to its
7 sole use as a residential area, in and all that piece or parcel of prop-
8 erty hereinafter designated as parcel no. 275, situate in the village of
9 Canastota, town of Lenox, county of Madison, as described in map 221
10 (Mohawk-Thruway-Madison County), filed in the Madison county clerk's
11 office on August 20, 1952.

12 § 3. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the New York state
13 thruway authority is hereby authorized and directed to take such action
14 as is necessary to release, extinguish and relinquish to the Interna-
15 tional Boxing Hall of Fame, Inc, its successors and assigns, any and all
16 conditions and/or reservations of the state that limit the use of the
17 real property more particularly described in section four of chapter 254
18 of the laws of 2013, as amended, and to release, extinguish and convey
19 to the International Boxing Hall of Fame, Inc any and all rights of
20 reverter and/or of reversion that the state may have in and to such real
21 property, such that such limits of use and/or the rights of reverter

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1 and/or reversion, shall be permanently released, extinguished and relin-
2 quished forever.

3 § 4. Any covenant, term, or condition in regard to the reversion to
4 the people of the state of New York under the jurisdiction of the New
5 York state thruway authority, in any deed or title instrument, or
6 contract of sale previously given pursuant to chapter 254 of the laws of
7 2013, as amended, shall be null and void.

8 § 5. This act shall take effect immediately.
