AN ACT to amend the general business law, in relation to requiring cell
towers to be equipped with a back-up power source in case of a power
outage

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assem-
bly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The general business law is amended by adding a new section
399-yyy to read as follows:

§ 399-yyy. Cellular network infrastructure; backup power. 1. Every
owner or operator of cellular network infrastructure located in this
state shall, to the extent practicable, equip all such cellular network
infrastructure with an emergency back-up power source capable of provid-
ing adequate power to maintain the operation of such cellular network
infrastructure in the case of a loss of power.

2. For the purposes of this section, "cellular network infrastructure"
shall mean any part of a radio telecommunications network that provides
wireless communications infrastructure to support cellular phones,
located throughout a geographical coverage area, including, but not
limited to, cell towers.

§ 2. This act shall take effect on the ninetieth day after it shall
have become a law.
