AN ACT to amend the retirement and social security law, in relation to additional member contributions for certain members under the age fifty-seven retirement program

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Paragraph 1 of subdivision f of section 604-d of the 2 retirement and social security law is amended by adding a new subparagraph (iv) to read as follows:

(iv) notwithstanding the provisions of subparagraph (ii) of this paragraph, a participant holding the title of carpenter, supervisor carpenter, ship carpenter, supervisor ship carpenter, rigger, dockbuilder, supervisor dockbuilder and general supervisor dockbuilder who is a participant in the age fifty-seven retirement program and whose age and 9 allowable service are such that he or she could not possibly be able to 10 accumulate at least twenty-five years of service by the time he or she reaches age fifty-seven, shall not be required to make the additional 11 member contribution pursuant to subparagraph (ii) of this paragraph. 13 Any participant in the titles listed in this subparagraph who has made 14 additional member contributions pursuant to subparagraph (ii) of this paragraph prior to the effective date of the chapter of the laws of two 15 16 thousand twenty-one that added this subparagraph shall receive a refund of the employee portion of such contributions plus interest provided 17 that their age and allowable service are such that he or she could not 18 19 possibly be able to accumulate at least twenty-five years of service by 20 the time he or she reaches age fifty-seven.

§ 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
