AN ACT to amend chapter 53 of the laws of 2021, enacting the aid to localities budget, in relation to providing for local fair emergency funds

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Section 1 of chapter 53 of the laws of 2021, enacting the aid to localities budget, is amended by repealing the items herein below set forth in brackets and by adding to such section the other items 4 underscored in this section:
