AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to requiring school boards to include information regarding the installation of a panic alarm system in any school in the district in the district-wide safety plan

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Paragraph f of subdivision 2 of section 2801-a of the 2 education law, as amended by section 1 of part B of chapter 54 of the 3 laws of 2016, is amended to read as follows:
- f. policies and procedures relating to school building security, including where appropriate the use of school safety officers and/or security devices, including but not limited to the installation of panic alarm systems, which for purposes of this section shall mean a silent security system signal generated by the manual activation of a device intended to signal a life-threatening or emergency situation requiring a response from law enforcement and which may include one or more of the following: wired panic button or buttons, wireless panic button or buttons or a mobile or computer application, or procedures;
- 13 § 2. Paragraph d of subdivision 3 of section 2801-a of the education 14 law, as amended by section 1 of part B of chapter 54 of the laws of 15 2016, is amended to read as follows:
- 16 d. establishment of internal and external communication systems in 17 emergencies <u>including but not limited to the installation of a panic</u> 18 <u>alarm system</u>;
- 19 § 3. This act shall take effect on the ninetieth day after it shall 20 have become a law.
