AN ACT to amend the judiciary law, in relation to requiring certain court of appeals judges to recuse themselves from serving as a juror during an impeachment trial of a governor that appointed them

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. The judiciary law is amended by adding a new section 60-a 2 to read as follows:

§ 60-a. Recusal as juror during impeachment trial. Any judge of the court of appeals that was appointed by the governor subject to a trial of impeachment, outlined in section twenty-four of article six of the state constitution, shall recuse himself or herself from serving on the court for the trial of impeachment.

8 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
