AN ACT to prohibit a government entity, its political subdivisions, agents or assigns from requiring individuals to wear face coverings or face masks

## The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, regulation, 1 2 guidance or executive order to the contrary, no government entity, or 3 its political subdivisions, agents, or assigns, shall be permitted to 4 require, as a condition of receiving any service or entering any place, 5 an individual to wear a face covering or face mask when such purpose for wearing the covering or mask is related to the COVID-19 virus. б

7 2. Nothing in this act shall prohibit a private entity from requiring, 8 as a condition of receiving any service or entering any place, an indi-9 vidual to wear a face covering or face mask.

3. Nothing in this act shall limit the ability of a nursing home, 10 11 long-term care facility or hospital to require an individual entering 12 such facility from wearing a face covering or face mask. 13

§ 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
