AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to authorizing the town of Hempstead in the county of Nassau to establish residential parking systems in the neighborhoods of Bellerose Terrace and Elmont

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Legislative findings and intent. The legislature finds that 2 a lack of parking for residents of certain areas of the town of Hempstead, Nassau county, has resulted in traffic hazards, congestion and air and noise pollution. In addition, such lack of parking poses a 5 hazard to residents and other pedestrians in such areas.

The legislature further finds that a residential parking system would be in the public interest. The legislature further finds that a residen-7 tial parking system will reduce such hazards and will reduce pollution levels as well. The legislature, therefore, hereby declares the necessi-10 ty of this act to authorize the town of Hempstead to adopt a residential parking permit system in accordance with the provisions of this act.

- 12 § 2. Section 1662-e of the vehicle and traffic law is amended by 13 adding two new subdivisions 2-a and 2-b to read as follows:
- 2-a. Such residential parking permit system may be established within 14 15 the area known as Elmont of the town consisting of the following road-16 ways:
 - (a) Holland Avenue north of Murray Hill Street;
- 18 (b) Elzey Avenue north of Murray Hill Street;
- 19 (c) Claridge Avenue north of Murray Hill Street;

- § 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
