AN ACT to amend the executive law and the state technology law, in relation to requiring state contractors and vendors to comply with the Web Content Accessibility Guidelines

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. The executive law is amended by adding a new section 170-f  
2 to read as follows:

3 § 170-f. Website accessibility; contractors and vendors. The office  
4 for people with developmental disabilities and the office of mental  
5 health, in consultation with the office of information technology  
6 services, shall require each website of a contractor, subcontractor,  
7 vendor, consultant or other person providing services pursuant to a  
8 state contract to conform to the most current version of the Web Content  
9 Accessibility Guidelines adopted by the World Wide Web Consortium for  
10 accessibility, or any successor standards.

11 § 2. Subdivisions 20 and 21 of section 103 of the state technology law  
12 are renumbered subdivisions 21 and 22, and a new subdivision 20 is added  
13 to read as follows:

14 20. To advise and assist the office for people with developmental  
15 disabilities and the office of mental health in assuring compliance with  
16 the Web Content Accessibility Guidelines by each contractor, subcontrac-  
17 tor, vendor, consultant or other person providing services pursuant to a  
18 state contract in accordance with section one hundred seventy-f of the  
19 executive law.

20 § 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
