AN ACT to amend the public housing law, in relation to the obligation to affirmatively further fair housing

## The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Subdivision 5 of section 600 of the public housing law, as added by a chapter of the laws of 2021 amending the public housing law relating to establishing an obligation to affirmatively further fair 4 housing, as proposed in legislative bills numbers S.1353-A and A.5428-A, is amended to read as follows:

5. The commissioner shall:

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- (a) on or before [October thirtieth] February first of two thousand twenty-two, and each fifth year thereafter, produce a draft report that shall be made available to the public. The report shall include any 10 significant initiatives, policies, or programs undertaken in furtherance 11 of fair housing and any recommendations for improving the state of fair 12 housing in New York. The draft report shall be open to a minimum of [thirty] twenty-one days of public comment. The commissioner shall, on 14 or before [December first] March tenth of each year that such report is 15 <u>due</u>, submit the final version of said report to the governor, the speak-16 er of the assembly, and the temporary president of the senate. The 17 commissioner shall submit along with the final report, all comments 18 received pursuant to the public comment period; and
- (b) on or before February first of every second and fourth year 20 following the issuance of the full report required pursuant to paragraph (a) of this subdivision, prepare an interim report explaining any 22 progress or significant changes to recommendations included in such full 23 report and detailing any new significant initiatives, policies, or 24 programs that have been undertaken in furtherance of fair housing. The interim report shall be submitted to the governor, the speaker of the assembly, and the temporary president of the senate.
- $\S$  2. This act shall take effect on the same date and in the same 27 28 manner as a chapter of the laws of 2021 amending the public housing law relating to establishing an obligation to affirmatively further fair 30 housing, as proposed in legislative bills numbers S.1353-A and A.5428-A, 31 takes effect.
