AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to including policies and procedures for responding to students having mental health crises in school safety plans

## The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Paragraphs 1 and m of subdivision 2 of section 2801-a of 2 the education law, as amended by chapter 30 of the laws of 2021, are amended to read as follows:

- 1. the designation of the superintendent, or superintendent's desig-5 nee, as the district chief emergency officer responsible for coordinating communication between school staff and law enforcement and first responders, and ensuring staff understanding of the district-level safety plan. The chief emergency officer shall also be responsible for ensuring the completion and yearly updating of building-level emergency 10 response plans; [and]
- 11 m. protocols for responding to a declared state disaster emergency 12 involving a communicable disease that are substantially consistent with 13 the provisions of section twenty-seven-c of the labor law: and
- 14 n. polices and procedures for responding to students having mental 15 health crises in a manner that does not include contacting law enforce-16 ment unless implied or direct threats of violence or other criminal 17 activity is involved.
- 18 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
