AN ACT to amend the public health law, in relation to providing direct reciprocal certification for certain emergency medical technicians

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The public health law is amended by adding a new section 3005-c to read as follows:

§ 3005-c. Emergency medical technicians; direct reciprocal certification. The commissioner, in consultation with the bureau of emergency
medical services, otherwise subject to the provisions of this article
and the rules of the department promulgated thereunder prescribing the
qualifications for an emergency medical technician, shall grant, without
payment of a fee or examination, a New York state emergency medical
technician certification to any individual who holds a current certification from the national registry of emergency medical technicians.
Renewals of certification under such grant of reciprocity shall be
deemed equivalent to renewals of certification pursuant to subdivision
two of section three thousand two of this article.

§ 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
