AN ACT to amend the general business law, in relation to requiring e-mail service providers to implement a procedure to authenticate an individual's identity when such individual creates an e-mail account

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The general business law is amended by adding a new section 2 390-d to read as follows:

§ 390-d. Identity authentication for e-mail accounts. 1. For the purposes of this section "e-mail service provider" shall mean any person, business or organization qualified to do business in this state that provides individuals, corporations, or other entities with the ability to send e-mail messages.

8 2. All e-mail service providers doing business in this state shall
9 develop and implement a procedure to authenticate an individual's iden10 tity when such individual creates a new e-mail account.

11 § 2. This act shall take effect on the ninetieth day after it shall 12 have become a law.
