AN ACT to amend the highway law, in relation to designating a certain portion of the state highway system as the "WWII Rapone Brothers Memorial Highway"

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The highway law is amended by adding a new section $344-\mathrm{n}$ to read as follows:
$\$ 344-n$. Portion of the state highway system to be designated as the "WWII Rapone Brothers Memorial Highway". All that portion of the state highway system constituting state route thirty-six from Graney road and its intersection with state route five, in the village of Caledonia, town of Caledonia, county of Livingston, shall be designated and known as the "WWII Rapone Brothers Memorial Highway".
§ 2. The commissioner of transportation shall provide for the installation and maintenance of adequate signing of the state highway system as designated pursuant to section one of this act. However, to avoid confusion and to limit any possible disruption of commerce, the designation called for pursuant to section one of this act shall be one of ceremonial nature and the official name of such highway shall not be changed as a result of this act.
§ 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
