AN ACT to amend the county law and the municipal home rule law, in relation to websites maintained by a county

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- Section 1. The county law is amended by adding a new section 55 to 2 read as follows:
- § 55. County websites. Any county which maintains a website shall use 4 <u>a ".gov" domain name for such website.</u>
- § 2. The municipal home rule law is amended by adding a new section 5 6 35-a to read as follows:

- § 35-a. County websites. Any county operating under a county charter 8 as defined in section thirty-two of this part which maintains a website shall use a ".gov" domain name for such website.
- 10 § 3. This act shall take effect one year after it shall have become a 11 law.
