AN ACT to amend the highway law, in relation to designating a portion of the state highway system the "Trooper Gerard B. Kane Memorial Bridge"

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The highway law is amended by adding a new section 344-n to 2 read as follows:

§ 344-n. Portion of the state highway system to be designated as the 4 "Trooper Gerard B. Kane Memorial Bridge". The bridge over the Southern 5 State Parkway on Deer Park Avenue between Parkdale Drive and Sylvan Road 6 in the town of Babylon, county of Suffolk, shall be designated and known as the "Trooper Gerard B. Kane Memorial Bridge".

- § 2. The commissioner of transportation shall provide for the installation and maintenance of adequate signing of the state highway system as designated pursuant to section one of this act. However, to avoid confusion and to limit any possible disruption of commerce, the desig-12 nation called for pursuant to section one of this act shall be one of 13 ceremonial nature and the official name of such bridge shall not be 14 changed as a result of this act.
 - § 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
