AN ACT to amend the family court act, in relation to increasing the number of judges in family court within the city of New York from fifty-six to sixty

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Section 121 of the family court act, as amended by chapter 2 44 of the laws of 2014, is amended to read as follows:

§ 121. Number of judges. The family court within the city of New York shall consist of [fifty-six] sixty judges, effective January first, two thousand [fifteen] twenty-three. There shall be at least one family court judge resident in each county of the city of New York.

§ 2. This act shall take effect January 1, 2023.
