AN ACT extending the time within which certain elected officers may file their oaths of office

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Notwithstanding any law, rule, or regulation to the contrary, any duly elected town officer or officers within the town of Clarkson, in the county of Monroe, as of the last town-wide election that
failed to take or file their respective oaths of office within the
statutorily prescribed period shall continue to serve in such capacity
and for the term from January 1, 2020 through December 31, 2023 upon the
taking and filing of oaths of office consistent with section 25 of the
town law provided such oaths are taken within 30 days from the effective
date of this act. Such town officer or officers that take and file their
oaths of office within 30 days of the effective date of this act shall
be deemed to have been continuously serving in office as of January 1,
2020.

§ 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
