- AN ACT to amend the economic development law, in relation to the eligibility criteria for the excelsior jobs program act

## The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Subdivision 6 of section 353 of the economic development 2 law, as amended by section 2 of part G of chapter 61 of the laws of 3 2011, is amended to read as follows:

6. A business entity must be in compliance with all worker protection and environmental laws and regulations. In addition, a business entity may not owe past due state taxes or local property taxes. In the event that a business entity is found to have violated such worker protection or environmental laws and regulations, pending a full audit by the state comptroller, the state shall order the surrender of all previous state subsidies issued to such business entity.

11 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
