3 § 5-1515. Duty to notify other trustees and beneficiaries. 1. When a 4 principal, who is a trustee of a trust, signs a power of attorney which 5 allows the agent to affect such trust and the agent is not a co-trustee 6 of such trust, the principal shall notify in writing all other co-trus-7 tees of the signing of a power of attorney and identify the person 8 assigned as the principal's agent. 2. When a principal, who is a beneficiary of a trust, signs a power of 9 10 attorney and the agent is not a co-beneficiary of such trust, the prin-

11 cipal shall notify in writing all other co-beneficiaries of the signing

12 of a power of attorney and identify the person assigned as the princi-

13 pal's agent.

14 § 2. This act shall take effect on the thirtieth day after it shall 15 have become a law.
