AN ACT to amend chapter 397 of the laws of 1996, relating to authorizing the town of Islip to lease certain lands to a business corporation, in relation to the lease term

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- Section 1. Subdivision (a) of section 1 of chapter 397 of the laws of 1996, relating to authorizing the town of Islip to lease certain lands to a business corporation, as amended by chapter 303 of the laws of 2012, is amended to read as follows:
- 5 (a) The town of Islip, in the county of Suffolk, is hereby authorized 6 and empowered to extend the terms of a lease between the town and a 7 business corporation dated July 30, 1996 that was authorized by chapter 8 397 of the laws of 1996 on the lands described in chapter 397 of the 9 laws of 1996 [for up to ten additional years] from the date of its expiration until January 1, 2046.
- 11 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
