AN ACT to amend chapter 476 of the laws of 1957 relating to authorizing the board of commissioners of the land office to grant certain easements in lands of the State University Agricultural and Technical Institute at Farmingdale to Central Hudson Gas and Electric Corporation, in relation to the description of lands for which the Commissioner of General Services is authorized to grant an easement to the Central Hudson Gas and Electric Corporation

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Sections 1 and 2 of chapter 476 of the laws of 1957, relating to authorizing the board of commissioners of the land office to grant certain easements in lands of the State University Agricultural and Technical Institute at Farmingdale to Central Hudson Gas and Electric Corporation, are amended to read as follows:
§ 1. The [boaxd of oommiscioners-of the land office, with] Commissioner of General Services, upon the consent [and approwal of the board of truoteeo of state Univeroity of New Yorle] of the Commissioner of the Department of Environmental Conservation, is hereby authorized to grant and convey to the Central Hudson Gas and Electric Corporation, [a-demeotic corporation organized and existing under the laws of the state of New Yoxk, easements in and aexoss two pareels of land of the State University Agricultural and Technical Institute at Farmingdale, hereinafter deseribed in seetion two of this aetr] an easement of state lands more accurately described in section two of this act, consisting of a portion of the Stony Kill Farm Environmental Education Center under the jurisdiction of the Department of Environmental Conservation for the purpose of constructing and maintaining electric transmission lines, upon such terms and conditions [ineluding eonoidexation as the board of eommiosionerg of the land offieemay fix and determine] deemed necessary and appropriate.

§ 2. [The lands in which the easements are authorined to be granted and conveyed may be surveyed by the New York state Department of Publie Works for a more aeourate-desoription and may be granted and eonveyed aecerding to oueh ourvey, but are genexally deseribed as followo: All those two pareelo of land oituate in the Towno of rishkill and-Wapping er, County of Dutehess and State of New York, bounded and deseribed as follows: Pareel 1. Beginning at a point in the property line and eenterline of the Baxtertown Road between he lands of the State of New York and Julius Moellex and at the southwestexly oornex of lands of Ham, said point being distant seventy-five feet eastexly (measured at right angles) from the survey eenterline of the propesed central Hudeon Gas and rleetrie Goxperation eleetrie transmission line, thenee south eight-y-four degreeg mexo minuteg-weot one hundred fifty-oix and four tenthe feet aleng the aforesaid propexty line and eentexline of the said road, thenee noxth ten degrees twenty-four minuteg eaot three hundred oixtythree and eight tenths feet, more ox less, parallel to and distant seventy-five feet westexly (measured at right angles) from the aforesaid survey eentexline to a point opposite an angle point in the aforementioned transmission line, thenee north eleven degrees fifty-two minutes west nine hundred sixty-two and three tenths feet, more or less, parallel and distant serenty-five feet westerly (meacured at right angles) from the aforesaid survel eenterline to a point opposite an angle point in he aforementioned tranomiosion line, thenee noxth fifty-three-degrees fifty-seren minutes east eight hundred nineteen and seven tentho feet, more or less, parallel and distant seventy-five feet northwestexly (measured at right angles) from the aforesaid survey eenterline to a point opposite an angle in the aforementioned transmission line, thenee north eleven degrees eight minutes-west thirteen hundred fifteen and four tenthe feet, more or less, parallel and distant seventymive feet westerly (measured at right angles) from the aforesaid surwey eenterline to a point in the property line stonewall between the lands of the state of New York and Fedward. M. Hurted, thenee noxth oixty nine-degrees fourteen minuteo eaot one hundred fifty-two and fourteen hundredtho feet along the said property line otonewall and aerose the aforesaid ourrey eenterline, thence south eleven degrees eight minutes east fourteen hundred thirty-six and six tenths feet, moxe or less, parallel and distant seventy-five feet easterly (measured at right angles) from the aforesaid survey eenterline to a point opposite an angle point in the aforementioned transmission line, thenee south fifty-three degrees fifty-seven minutes-west eight hundred eighteen and three tenthr feet, moxe or less, parallel and distant seventy-five feet southeasterly (meaoured at right angleg) from the afoxesaid ourver eentexline to a point in a dixt road in range with the souxthexly property line otonewall of lands of the state of New York, said point also being opposite an angle point in the aforementioned transmission line, thenee south eleven degrees fifty-two minutes east eight hundred ninety-for and eight tenths feet, more or less, parallel and distant seventy-five feet eastexly (measured at right angles) from the aforesaid survey eenterline to a point opposite an angle point in the aforementioned transmission liner thenee south ten degrees twenty-four minutes west three hundred fortynine and one tenth feet, moxe or less, parallel and distant seventy-five feet eaotexly (meaoured at right angleg) from the aforeoaid ourver eentexline to the plaee of begiming, eontaining elewen and ninety-eight hundredths aeres, more or less. Pareel 2. Beginning at a southeasterly eorner of the lands of the State of New York approximately three hundred twenty feet south of the Baxtextown Road at the line of lands of Julius

Moellex, said point being forty-seven and six tenthe feet westerly (measured at right angles) from the survey eenterline of the propesed Gentral Hudson Gas and Fleetrie Gorporation electric trancmiscion liner thenee south eighty-one-degrees fifty-five minutes-weot along lando-of Moellex twenty-eight and eight tentho feet, more or leos, thenee noxth ten degrees twenty-eight minutes east fifty-one feet, more or less, parallel to and distant seventy-five feet westexly (measured at right angles) from the aforementioned survey eentexline, thenee south twenty-two-degrees forty-two minutes east fortymine and six tenths feet, more or less, along lands of Moellex to the plaee of beginning, oontaining sixteen thousandthe aeres, more or lese.]

The lands for which the Commissioner of General Services is authorized by section one of this act to grant an easement to the Central Hudson Gas and Electric Corporation are described as follows:

All that certain tract, piece or parcel of land situate in the Town of Fishkill and Town of Wappinger, County of Dutchess, State of New York and being more particularly bounded and described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point in the centerline of Baxtertown Road; thence along the centerline of Baxtertown Road South 66050'38" West 158.26 feet to a point; thence through the lands of The People of the State of New York (Liber 602, page 292) the following four courses and distance:

1. North $04^{\circ} 33^{\prime} 48^{\prime \prime}$ West, passing a capped rod set at 17.41 feet, a total distance of 385.93 feet to a capped rod set;
2. North $26^{\circ} 59^{\prime} 24^{\prime \prime}$ West 960.41 feet to a capped rod set;
3. North $399^{\circ} 32^{\prime \prime} 02^{\prime \prime}$ East 819.95 feet to a capped rod set;
4. North $26^{\circ} 07^{\prime} 06^{\prime \prime}$ West, passing a capped rod set at 1301.59 feet, a total distance of 1309.70 feet to a point in the division line with of Laura D. Ligotino, Margo S. Husted and Timothy J. Husted (Book 22011, page 5219);

Thence along said division line North $50^{\circ} 18^{\prime \prime} 46^{\prime \prime}$ East 154.31 feet to a point; thence through the lands of The People of the State of New York (Liber 602, page 292) the following two courses and distances:

1. South 26007'06" East, passing a capped rod set at 22.69 feet, a total distance of 1454.95 feet to a capped rod set;
2. South 39017'11" West 123.02 feet to an iron pipe found;

Thence along the division line with lands of Paul Alfred and Pearl Alfred (Book 974, page 113) and continuing along the division line with lands of Executive Properties Services LLC (Book 22012, page 5488) South 39017'11" West 663.49 feet to a point;

Thence through the lands of The People of the State of New York (Liber 602, page 292) the following three courses and distance:

1. South $39^{\circ} 17^{\prime \prime} 1^{\prime \prime}$ West 33.16 feet to a capped rod set;
2. South 26059'24" East 875.70 feet to a capped rod set;
3. South $04^{\circ} 33^{\prime \prime} 4^{\prime \prime}$ East, passing a capped rod set at 347.80 feet, a total distance of 365.21 feet to the point of beginning.

Containing 12.29 acres, being the same more or less.
Bearings refer to Grid North, New York State Plane Coordinate System, Eastern Zone, based on the HARN System.
§ 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
