AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to the unlawful purchase or possession of a body vest

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The penal law is amended by adding a new section 270.21 to
 read as follows:
 <u>§ 270.21 Unlawful purchase or possession of a body vest.</u>
 <u>A person is guilty of the unlawful purchase or possession of a body</u>

5 vest when he or she knowingly and unlawfully purchases or possesses a 6 body vest, as such term is defined in subdivision two of section 270.20 7 of this article. This section shall not apply to active law enforcement 8 officers, firefighters, and other first responders, or those whose occu-9 pations require the use of body vests as determined by the department of 10 state. 11 Unlawful purchase or possession of a body vest is a class A misdemea-

12 nor for a first offense and a class E felony for any subsequent offense.
13 § 2. Any person currently in possession of a body vest, as such term
14 is defined in subdivision 2 of section 270.20 of the penal law, shall

15 have 15 days from the effective date of this act to dispose of such body 16 vest at any local or state law enforcement agency.

17 § 3. This act shall take effect on the sixtieth day after it shall 18 have become a law.
