AN ACT to amend the navigation law, in relation to revoking a person's driver's license following the conviction of operating a vessel while under the influence of alcohol or drugs

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Section 49-a of the navigation law is amended by adding a 2 new subdivision 3-a to read as follows:
- 3 3-a. Privilege to operate a motor vehicle; suspension. The court shall suspend a person's privilege to operate a motor vehicle and may suspend a motor vehicle registration in the same manner as defined under subdivision two of section eleven hundred ninety-three of the vehicle and traffic law where an operator is convicted of a violation of paragraph
- 8 (a), (b), (d) or (e) of subdivision two of this section or a violation of section forty-nine-b of this part.
- § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
